- **Domestic Animals**

Animals that are kept on farms or near our homes are called domestic animals. They are useful to man. Examples cows, dogs, ducks and cats.

- **Pet Animals**

They are animals that stay at home with us. We feed and take care of them. We should love and care for them. Examples dog, parrot, fish and cat.

- **Wild Animals**

They live in forests. They add beauty and diversity to our lives

Examples lion, tiger, elephant, giraffe and bear.

- **Birds**

They fly in the air with the help of their wings. Light weight birds can fly high up in the sky like the crow, pigeon, sparrow and kingfisher. Large birds having heavy weight cannot fly high up in the sky like the penguin and the ostrich.

- **Insects**

They are very small animals .They have six legs .Some insects have wings to fly like the butterfly .Other examples are ant ,mosquito ,bees and housefly.

There are 5 butterflies

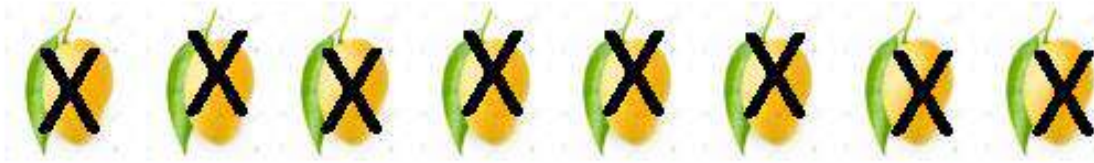
No butterfly fly away
