Towards the realization of the motto, SGS assures robust quality procedures and opportunities to its stakeholders to be equipped with knowledge and skills of the modern era. Due commitment along with creativity and sensitiveness across the curriculum with the highest academic standards, the school aims to provide a secular environment where in students learn well, behave well and respect well.

Academic Achievements: The academic year 2025–26 has been a year of growth, achievement, and innovation. Our students have continued to bring laurels to the school through their outstanding performance in academics.

- In the **CBSE Class X Board Examination 2024-25**, 100% of our students passed, where 82% **secured distinction**. 81% was the school average.
- In **Class XII**, the overall result was equally commendable with **students excelling in Science, Commerce, and Humanities streams** and the school average standing at 83%.
- Our students also performed extraordinarily well in the **NEET and JEE** competitive exams. **(detailed report in PPT)**

Staff achievement

Our teachers are the true pillars of St. Gregorios School — mentors who inspire, guide, and shape young minds with dedication and care. The year 2025–26 has been a year of growth and professional advancement for our staff. We are proud that some of our staff members have been **recognized for their excellence in teaching and commitment**. A few of our teachers received **Best Teacher Awards** from various educational bodies and organizations.

Co-curricular Activities

The school strongly believes in the holistic development of students, and this year has witnessed vibrant participation in a wide range of activities.

- **Cultural Activities:** The school community celebrated **different festivals and events of national importance and interest**, brought out the artistic and cultural talents of our students. The **school choir** and **dance troupe** performed at various level events, receiving much appreciation from inter school, Zonal, District and state level competitions. **(detailed report in PPT)**
- **Exhibitions:** Students displayed creativity through young entrepreneurs' activities, art & craft and social science Exhibitions Their paintings and models were displayed during exhibitions.
- As an active member of the **Sankalp Sahodaya of Dwarka**, the school successfully organised a series of inter-school competitions in **music, dance, debate, and art**, encouraging creativity and healthy competition among students. The school also hosted the prestigious **Dr. Paulose Mar Gregorios Memorial Football Match**, which witnessed enthusiastic participation and displayed exemplary sportsmanship. **Zennit** is an initiative of *St. Gregorios School* designed to foster collaboration and healthy competition among neighbourhood schools through a range of inter-school events. This year, **46 schools participated**, and **St. Gregorios School emerged as the overall champion**, securing the **First Position**.
- **Sports and Games:** Our young Gregorians recorded commendable achievements in different competitions in diverse co-curricular areas at **inter-school**, zonal, district level, state level and national level in athletics, Skating, Shooting, football, baseball, softball, Kabaddi, Music, Dance, Yoga, art and craft showcasing the multifaceted talents of our students and their commitment to excellence beyond academics. **(detailed report in PPT)**
- **Clubs and Houses:** Various clubs especially the Eco Club and the NCC unit, remained active throughout the year, organizing

awareness drives, exhibitions, and quiz competitions. Community service remains close to our heart, our students visited old-age homes, orphanages, planted trees, and participated in cleanliness campaigns, living the values of compassion and service. Our self-defence training team for senior female students remained very active. **House wise activities were organised in the school and as of now the green house has scored 492 points, red house 470 points, Blue House 455 points and Yellow House 441 points.**

- **Picnics** and various **student exposure** programs were organised in accordance with the evolving requirements of the time.
- **The Annual Day** of the school was organised in two slots on the 7th and 8th of November 2025. The first day featured performances by students of classes LKG to II, while the second day included participants from classes III to XII.
- **Primary School Activities:** The **Primary Wing** of the school continued to focus on fostering intellectual curiosity, creativity, and moral values among students. Throughout the academic year, students participated in a variety of **co-curricular and enrichment activities** designed to promote confidence and teamwork. Events such as **recitation, storytelling, quiz competitions, and creative writing** encouraged self-expression and critical thinking. The celebration of **festivals and important national days** provided opportunities for students to appreciate the country's cultural heritage and traditions. The Primary Wing remained committed to providing a balanced education that nurtures academic excellence, character building, and social awareness.
- **Professional Development:** Throughout the year, several capacity-building workshops and training programmes were conducted by CBSE as well as internal resource persons to help teachers stay aligned with evolving educational practices. A total of **58 hours of training** were provided to teachers on various topics. Additionally, **seven workshops** were organised for parents, and **47 workshops** were conducted for students in both small and large groups. A **career fair** was also organised in the school with the support of *Dwarka City* newspaper.
