More Addition

Addition of a two digit number with a single digit number(without regrouping)

Example:

Add 23 and 4

T	O
2	3
+	4
<hr style="border: 0.5px solid black;"/>	
2	7

Steps:

- 1) Place the digits in tens (T) and ones (O) place.
- 2) Write the + sign.
- 3) Add the digits in the ones place .
Keep 3 in mind ,open 4 fingers then start counting after 3 on fingers to get 7.
- 4) Then look at the tens place
2 is the digit and there is no digit below 2 so 2 will come down in answer .
- 5) So answer will be 27

Addition of a two digit number with a two digit number (without regrouping)

Example:

Add 34 and 12

Steps:

- 1) Place the digits in tens(T) and ones(O) place.
- 2) Write the + sign.
- 3) Add the digits in ones place.
- 4) Add the digits in the tens place.
