Dress Code Guidelines for Parents/Guardians Visiting the School

Parents/Guardians are an integral part of the school community and are expected to maintain the dignity and decorum of the institution while visiting the school premises.

To ensure a **respectful, decent, and professional school environment**, all parents/guardians are requested to adhere to the following dress-code guidelines:

General Guidelines

- Parents/Guardians should wear **clean, decent, modest, and presentable attire** while visiting the school.
- Clothing should be appropriate to the **school environment and the purpose of the visit**.
- Parents/Guardians are expected to maintain a neat and well-groomed appearance.
- Attire should not be excessively casual, revealing, transparent, or inappropriate for an educational institution.

For Male Parents/Guardians

Recommended attire includes:

- Formal or semi-formal shirts with trousers.
- Collared T-shirts with chinos or formal trousers.
- Neat and modest traditional Indian attire such as kurta-pajama or kurta with trousers.
- Formal shoes, loafers, or other clean and appropriate footwear.

Parents/Guardians are requested to avoid:

- Shorts, very short trousers, or sleeveless vests.
- Ripped or distressed jeans.
- Sleeveless or excessively casual T-shirts.


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- Clothing carrying offensive, inappropriate, or objectionable slogans/images.
- Sports/gym wear, nightwear, or excessively casual footwear while visiting the school for official purposes.

For Female Parents/Guardians

Recommended attire includes:

- Saree with an appropriate blouse.
- Salwar-kameez or other modest Indian attire.
- Kurta with trousers or other appropriate bottoms.
- Formal or smart-casual western attire that is modest and suitable for a school environment.
- Clean and appropriate footwear.

Parents/Guardians are requested to avoid:

- Very short dresses, skirts, or shorts.
- Crop tops or excessively revealing attire.
- Deep necklines or very low-cut clothing.
- Transparent or excessively sheer clothing.
- Clothing that is excessively tight or otherwise unsuitable for a school environment.
- Sports/gym wear or beachwear.

Special Occasions and Meetings

For meetings with the **Principal, school authorities, Parent-Teacher Meetings, official functions, or other formal occasions**, parents/guardians are expected to dress in **formal or smart-casual attire** appropriate to the occasion.

The purpose of these guidelines is **not to impose personal preferences regarding clothing**, but to ensure that everyone visiting the school contributes to an atmosphere of **dignity, mutual respect, discipline, and professionalism**.

Parents/Guardians are requested to extend their cooperation and help the school maintain the decorum of the institution.
